NEW TREES FOR KENTS HILL

Thanks to the generosity of local residents a number of saplings have been planted among the hedgerows which border the playing fields in Kents Hill local park.

The Oak and Sweet Chestnuts were grown from seed in plant pots and grown on until they were between 250 and 500 mm. high.

A group of the residents and Parish Councillors guided by a MK Council landscape expert found small clearings where the trees will hopefully thrive. In 10 years time they should be well over 4 metres tall.
