

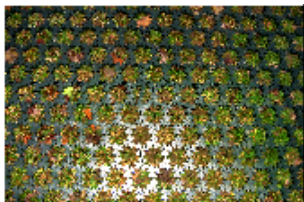
MAY THE FORCE BE WITH YOU

We are working with MK Council's Continuous Improvement team on parking solutions in our Parish.

The grass verge trial in Easby Grove, Monkston is still in progress.



Local residents have seen a possible solution based on a plastic interlocking tile structure which is being piloted over the winter. Further grass verge areas in Lindisfarne Drive are also to be trialled in Early 2009.



The green coloured tiles are made from 100% recycled material, have a long working life and can support heavy loads without damage. In our case they can prevent damage to underlying pipes and cables.

In some of the very narrow roads on our estates, and where households have several cars, it is sometimes very necessary to find a parking place that allows emergency and other wider vehicles essential access.

This could be the answer!
