



**MINUTES OF PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON MONDAY 9TH APRIL 2018, 7.30PM
AT KINGSTON LIBRARY**

Before the meeting commenced, the Chair read out a statement informing the meeting that he would be rigorously applying standing orders during the meeting, particularly around rules of debate at meetings. He advised members and visitors that there would be a limited time for questions and answers as per the standing orders. He also informed the meeting that in the interests of transparency he had referred himself to the Monitoring Officer after allegations by another Councillor of impropriety around declarations of interests.

Public Session:

Cllr Terry Reynolds (Walton Community Council) – Cllr Reynolds introduced himself to the meeting as the Chair of WCC and stated he was attending in the ‘spirit of friendship’.

Member of the public – Asked about the Chair’s statement as she felt it wasn’t right that members were not permitted to have more than their allotted time. She felt that the Chair was impeding discussions. The Chair responded by advising the visitor that Council had adopted the standing orders and that application of the standing orders was necessary to give all members the right to speak equally, and to stop the proceedings being dominated by one member or members.

Cllr Jenni Ferrans (MKC) – Cllr Ferrans stated that she had not seen any progress on the issue she previously raised about relocating the dog waste bin on Bridlington Crescent. The Clerk advised that she had requested a quote for moving the bin but had not had a response yet.

RESOLVED The minutes of the extraordinary parish council meeting held on Monday 19th March 2018 were approved with one amendment to agenda item 146/2017</p> <p><i>"A councillor expressed concern about the legal validity of the decision to award the grant to 1st Broughton & Monkston Guides (minute ref: 133/2017) stating that if a councillor had an interest in an agenda item then the standing orders of the parish council required that councillor to leave the room which would have an effect on the quorum for the meeting as the absent councillor would not be regarded as being 'present and voting'. It was advised that the interest in the given case was personal and not pecuniary so the councillor with the interest did not have to be excluded from the meeting and that the vote had been by acclamation. The concern was raised that by virtue of the very fact of a councillor disclosing the interest, the disclosure should have been given effect to, in accordance with the standing orders. Another councillor suggested that the interest was related more to the councillor's wife being an officer in a related organisation of the organisation seeking the grant and that all the right questions had been asked of the grant seeking organisation. VC abstained from the vote to approve payment to 1st Broughton and Monkston Guides as a financial concern had been raised.
